CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP
NOVEMBER 9, 2011**

1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Eisinger opened the Commission Meeting and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. GREEN PLAN PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION

Cooper City Sustainability Plan
Cooper City Green Initiatives

The Commission was previously presented with a printed Sustainability Plan by the Green Advisory Board and Green Initiatives as a recommendation to the City. Board Chairman Diane Guidry ran the PowerPoint presentation to the Commission.

Several members of the Board who were in attendance described their first choices for priority implementation of the initiatives, based on ease of execution, community interest and feasibility.

Unanimous consensus was reached to direct staff to post the presentation to the City's website for public viewing.

5. SIGN CODE ORDINANCE

Proposed Ordinance No. P11-19

Atty. Johanna Lundgren provided clarification of the proposed sign code ordinance as well as statutory limitations.

Consensus was reached to include the following changes to the proposed ordinance prior to first reading:

- **Remove the bond requirement for signs posted in residential areas.**
- **Increase the limit on the number of Open House real estate signs allowed per event from 1 on-site/2 off-site directional to 1 on-site/4 off-site directional signs in residential areas.**

- **Decrease the number of signs posted on non-residential property from 5 to 1, which would prompt the need for a bond to be posted.**
- **Limit the time period for posting political signs to 90 days prior to the given election or upon qualifying, whichever is shorter.**
