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## I. CODE ENFORCEMENT

Handle applicable county court prosecutions for code violations and related activities. Provide legal services for preparation and presentation of cases before city special magistrate; and assist in facilitating the operation of successful special magistrate program (Pablo Tamayo, Douglas Gonzales);

## II. LITIGATION

- 1) Defend City in fire assessment case. The Circuit Court granted plaintiff's motion to certify a class of plaintiffs. We had filed a Notice of Appeal of that preliminary ruling to the Fourth District Court of Appeal, as authorized by the City Manager; and have filed the City's Briefs. Oral argument was held at the 4<sup>th</sup> District on November 5, 2013. By Per Curiam decision of November 14, 2013, the 4<sup>th</sup> District ( without a written opinion) affirmed the Circuit Court's certification of a class of plaintiffs to allow the case to proceed as a class action. Since the appellate court decision returned the case to the Trial Court, the previous stay or hold on trial court proceedings is removed , and the defense of the case will proceed at the Trial Court level pursuant to the several defenses asserted in the City's previously filed Answer and Affirmative Defenses. On June 2, 2014, the Trial Court issued an Agreed Order requiring the Plaintiffs to publish and mail a notice of the pending class action litigation , as required by the rules governing class actions , so that persons who are alleged to be part of the class may know of the class action and may decide whether to remain in or exclude themselves from the class action as the case proceeds. No trial date has been set. ( Ed Guedes, Matt Mandel );



PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.**

This Notice is given pursuant to an Order of the Circuit Court of the State of Florida, Broward County, in accordance with Fla. R. Civ. P. 1.220(d). This Notice is to advise you about the pendency of the above styled class action lawsuit, which has been certified as being able to be brought on a class basis by a Broward County Circuit Court. This lawsuit was brought on behalf of residential property owners in Cooper City who may have been required to pay for fire rescue assessments to Cooper City for the tax years commencing 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. You may be such a property owner.

The Plaintiffs contend these Cooper City property owners have been required to pay special assessments for fire rescue to Cooper City for the tax years commencing October 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 and that Cooper City improperly assessed for and used these assessments to fund emergency medical services. The Plaintiffs assert that the use of special assessment funds to pay for emergency medical services is illegal. Cooper City disputes the Plaintiffs' claims and denies that by fire assessment was illegal or improper.

The Court entered an Order Granting Class Certification January 25, 2013. The purpose of this Notice to advise you of these proceedings, and the potential effect on your rights in advance of any trial.



### **THE COURT'S RULING**

The Court has ruled that this claim may be maintained not only by the individuals named in the Complaint, but also on behalf of a Class consisting of the above described residential property owners in Cooper City. The Court has named WALTER S. JOLLIFF and BRENDA J. KEZAR, as Class Representatives and their attorneys, Christopher J. Lynch, Esquire and David Frankel, Esquire as Class Counsel. The Class consists of all record title owners of residential real property located within Cooper City subject to the Cooper City Fire Rescue Assessment, who paid the Cooper City Fire Rescue Assessment for the fiscal tax years commencing October 1, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. In other words, the affected property owners will have owned property in Cooper City and paid to Cooper City Fire Rescue Assessments for the tax years commencing October 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009.

### **ELECTION BY CLASS MEMBERS**

If you fit the above description of a Class Member, you have a choice whether to remain a member of the Class on whose behalf this suit is being maintained, or to be excluded from the Class. If you want to be excluded from the Class, you must complete the enclosed form (Request for Exclusion) and return it to Class Counsel, Post Office Box, \_\_\_\_\_, Miami, Florida 33133, by mail, postmarked no later than 30 days after [date of mailing]. By making this election to be excluded, (1) you will not share in any recovery that might be paid to property owners as a result of a trial or settlement of this lawsuit; (2) you will not be bound by any decision in this suit; (3) you may present any claims you have against Cooper City by filing your own lawsuit subject to the statute of limitations or other defenses; or (4) you may seek to intervene in this lawsuit.

If you want to remain a member of the Class, you should not file the "Request for Exclusion" and you are not required to do anything at this time. By remaining a Class Member, and not filing the Request for Exclusion, any claims against the Defendant for damages or other relief alleged or which could have been alleged by the Class Representatives will be determined in this case and cannot be presented in any other lawsuit.

### **RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF CLASS MEMBERS**

If you remain a member of the Class:

1. The named Plaintiffs and their attorneys will act as your representative and counsel for the presentation of the claims against the Defendant. If you desire, you may appear by your own attorney. You may also seek to intervene individually and may advise the Court if at any time you consider that you are not being fairly and adequately represented by the named Plaintiffs and their attorneys.

2. All members of the Class who do not request exclusion, as previously described, and who are therefore deemed to have elected to participate in this action, will be entitled a pro rata share in the benefits, if any, of any judgment favorable to the Class or in any

settlement of their claims, after deduction of attorney's fees and disbursements, if awarded by the Court, but they will also be bound by any judgment unfavorable to the Class. Included class members will also be subject to the orders and notices subsequently given in this action with reference to the furnishing of statements and other matters of that nature.



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During the month of May, Deputies assigned to the Cooper City District responded to 2791 calls for service. Of these calls for service, a total of 46 are Part One (Persons and Property Crimes). The remaining 2,745 calls are alarms, police service suspicious incidents, 911 hang ups, etc.

There were a total of 6 residential burglaries, 17 conveyance burglaries, 2 sexual assaults. There were 54 arrests during the month in which some are documented below in the Items of Interest section of this report.

A total of 141 code violations were addressed during the month of May. These violations are initiated by Patrol Deputies, Parking Enforcement Personnel and Code Enforcement Inspectors. Many of these cases and will require additional follow-up action.

Also included in this report is a breakdown of the 424 State Traffic Citations and 174 Traffic Warnings issued by District Deputies. The Accident Report by Zone lists a total of 73 accidents investigated by District Deputies during the month of May, there was one traffic fatality.
