I. CODE ENFORCEMENT

Handle applicable county court prosecutions for code violations and related activities. Provide legal services for preparation and presentation of cases before city special magistrate; and assist in facilitating the operation of successful special magistrate program (Pablo Tamayo, Douglas Gonzales);

II. LITIGATION

- 1) Defend City in fire assessment case. The Circuit Court granted plaintiff's motion to certify a class of plaintiffs. We had filed a Notice of Appeal of that preliminary ruling to the Fourth District Court of Appeal, as authorized by the City Manager; and have filed the City's Briefs. Oral argument was held at the 4th District on November 5, 2013. By Per Curiam decision of November 14, 2013, the 4th District (without a written opinion) affirmed the Circuit Court's certification of a class of plaintiffs to allow the case to proceed as a class action. Since the appellate court decision returned the case to the Trial Court, the previous stay or hold on trial court proceedings is removed , and the defense of the case will proceed at the Trial Court level pursuant to the several defenses asserted in the City's previously filed Answer and Affirmative Defenses. On June 2, 2014, the Trial Court issued an Agreed Order requiring the Plaintiffs to publish and mail a notice of the pending class action litigation , as required by the rules governing class actions , so that persons who are alleged to be part of the class may know of the class action and may decide whether to remain in or exclude themselves from the class action as the case proceeds. No trial date has been set. (Ed Guedes, Matt Mandel);

- 5) Assist City management in review of Park Agreement amendment ; and follow-up (Ignacio Del Valle);
- 6) Assist Growth Management department on matter of school as accessory use to church (Kathy Mehaffey);
- 7) Assist City administration in amendment/ update to Chapter 9 (Business Taxes) of City Code (Alan Gabriel , David Wolpin);
- 8) Assist City administration in amendment to Chapter 12 of City Code concerning dogs in Parks (Alan Gabriel ; David Wolpin);
- 9) Assist City Manager on proposed ordinance amendment concerning driveway/ sidewalk maintenance (Alan Gabriel); and

Subject: June 2014 Report

During the month of June, Deputies assigned to the Cooper City District responded to 2703 calls for service. Of these calls for service, a total of 36 are Part One (Persons and Property Crimes). The remaining 2,667 calls are alarms, police service suspicious incidents, 911 hang ups, etc.

There were a total of 2 residential burglaries, 6 conveyance burglaries, and 4 auto thefts. There were 37 arrests during the month in which some are documented below in the Items of Interest section of this report.

A total of 119 code violations were addressed during the month of June. These violations are initiated by Patrol Deputies, Parking Enforcement Personnel and Code Enforcement Inspectors. Many of these cases and will require additional follow-up action.

Also included in this report is a breakdown of the 368 State Traffic Citations and 220 Traffic Warnings issued by District Deputies. The Accident Report by Zone lists a total of 55 accidents investigated by District Deputies during the month of June, there were no traffic fatality.

Items of Interest:

Items of Interest :

On 06.05.14 deputies responded to 5861 SW 99 Lane regarding a burglary to a residence in progress. The caller (juvenile resident) told the 911 operator that she was upstairs and a black male had just shattered the downstairs window and was gaining entry into the home. The juvenile was able to stay on the phone with the 911 operator and provide updated details. During this event fearing for her safety the juvenile exited her residence via the second floor bedroom window and jumped to the ground floor still providing updates. Deputies were able to apprehend Kwamayne Davis as he was fleeing from the residence. There was a second suspect who was driving a get-a-way vehicle who was able to flee before deputies arrived. Investigation continues. The juvenile will be honored at the next Sheriff's Office Award Ceremony.

On 06.17.14 Deputy Haber conducted a traffic stop on defendant Dan Delva for speeding. During the contact with the defendant Deputy Haber could smell marijuana coming from the vehicle. After having the defendant exit the vehicle, Deputy Haber observed marijuana all over the defendant's clothes and the drivers seat. Deputy Haber also located a firearm in the glove compartment. Defendant charged with possession of marijuana and a weapons violation.

On 06.24.14 Deputy Haber conducted a traffic stop on defendant Raechel Joanne Ferrero regarding an expired tag. During the encounter the defendant was extremely nervous and kept looking around. Upon consent to search the vehicle, a trafficking amount of Oxycodone was discovered in the vehicle along with \$11,000 in cash. Major Narcotics detectives responded to the scene and interviewed the defendant. Information was obtained from the defendant on her supplier.

On 06.28.14 Deputy Legra conducted a traffic stop on defendant Derek Adam Becker regarding an equipment violation. During the encounter the defendant was acting very nervous which altered Deputy Legra. Deputy Legra asked for consent to search the defendant. The defendant agreed but just prior to the search admitted having needles and morphine in his possession. Defendant was charged with narcotics violations.

On 06.28.14 Andrew Arndt was acting irrational at the Sunoco gas station located at 12200 Griffin Road. The suspect started destroying display cases and throwing bottles of wine on the floor. Responding deputies met with the suspect as he was sitting inside the car wash. The suspect refused orders to lay on the ground and resisted the deputies. The suspect was hit with the Taser and baton and continued to violently fight with deputies. Suspect charged with Resisting With Violence and Criminal Mischief




