I. CODE ENFORCEMENT

Handle applicable county court prosecutions for code violations and related activities. Provide legal services for preparation and presentation of cases before city special magistrate; and assist in facilitating the operation of successful special magistrate program (Pablo Tamayo, Douglas Gonzales);

II. LITIGATION

- 1) Defend City in fire assessment case. The Circuit Court granted plaintiff's motion to certify a class of plaintiffs. We had filed a Notice of Appeal of that preliminary ruling to the Fourth District Court of Appeal, as authorized by the City Manager; and have filed the City's Briefs. Oral argument was held at the 4th District on November 5, 2013. By Per Curiam decision of November 14, 2013, the 4th District (without a written opinion) affirmed the Circuit Court's certification of a class of plaintiffs to allow the case to proceed as a class action. Since the appellate court decision returned the case to the Trial Court, the previous stay or hold on trial court proceedings is removed, and the defense of the case will proceed at the Trial Court level pursuant to the several defenses asserted in the City's previously filed Answer and Affirmative Defenses. On June 2, 2014, the Trial Court issued an Agreed Order requiring the Plaintiffs to publish and mail a notice of the pending class action litigation, as required by the rules governing class actions, so that persons who are alleged to be part of the class may know of the class action and may decide whether to remain in or exclude themselves from the class action as the case proceeds. Plaintiffs mailed and published a notice, and have recently repeating the notice process because of a defect in the return mailing address that they used in the first attempted notice. The discovery process is on-going. Plaintiffs recently filed a motion for partial summary judgment. We are examining that motion and will be responding to it. No hearing has been

scheduled on the motion. No trial date has been set. (Matt Mandel, Jamie Cole);

III. OTHER MATTERS

- 1) Handle labor issues and provide labor related advice for Human Resources (Alison Smith, Brett Schneider);
- 2) Represent City as a party plaintiff in asset distribution litigation against Broward County and in related dispute resolution and mediation proceedings, concerning Resource Recovery Board / Solid Waste system , as authorized by City Commission. An attorney- client session to discuss a potential settlement offer was recently held. Settlement approval is being processed by the largest municipalities first in advance of County Commission approval (Dan Abbott, Jamie Cole);
- 3) Advise on implementation of County ethics ordinances, and provide advisory opinions, assistance and advice on public service ethics when requested (David Wolpin, Robert Meyers);
- 4) As requested by City Manager, assist staff with collection of delinquent utility bills including late fees (Aleida Molina , David Wolpin);
- 5) Assist City Manager on computer funding grant to Cooper City Izone Schools as authorized by City Commission (David Wolpin) ;
- 6) Assist City Manager and Public Works Director on Sidewalk Ordinance amendment (David Wolpin);
- 7) Assist City Manager and Growth Management Director on Public School signage, Sign Code amendment (Kathy Mehaffey, David Wolpin); and
- 8) Examine Agenda Items for March 10, 2015, City Commission meeting (David Wolpin) .





Subject: February 2015 Report

During the month of February, Deputies assigned to the Cooper City District responded to 2599 calls for service. Of these calls for service, a total of 30 are Part One (Persons and Property Crimes). The remaining 2569 calls are alarms, police service suspicious incidents, 911 hang ups, etc.

There were a total of 7 conveyance burglaries, 2 sexual batteries, 1 robbery and 1 residential burglary. There were 30 arrests during the month in which some are documented below in the Items of Interest section of this report.

A total of 150 code violations were addressed during the month of February. These violations are initiated by Patrol Deputies, Parking Enforcement Personnel and Code Enforcement Inspectors. Many of these cases and will require additional follow-up action.

Also included in this report is a breakdown of the 224 State Traffic Citations and 238 Traffic Warnings issued by District Deputies. The Accident Report by Zone lists a total of 53 accidents investigated by District Deputies during the month of February, there were no traffic fatalities.

Items of Interest :

02.02.15 Detective Gainey arrested Akeem Addison for obtaining a prescription (Codeine) from the Walmart pharmacy with a fraudulent prescription.

02.06.15 Deputy Gene Legra located Shane Howard Miles who is a convicted sex offender. Suspect Miles was in violation of Florida State Statute requiring him to provide his residence address to the County and to the State of Florida. The last time suspect Miles provided his address was on 01.31.2013. Deputy Legra knew that the Broward Sheriff's Office Sex Crimes Division had been looking for suspect when he spotted him in front of Starbucks. Suspect Miles was arrested for the violation and a separate charge of possession of marijuana.

02.14.15 Jhony Milo was arrested at the Wal-Mart after putting \$1,279.16 worth of merchandise in a shopping cart and passing by the registers and walking out the front doors without paying for the items.

02.17.15 John Gomez and Joel Brito were additional charged with another count of burglary to a residence and grand theft. Both of these suspects were arrested in January after committing multiple burglaries in the Monterra development.

02.19.15 While Deputy Clark was conducting speed enforcement in the 8600 block of Sheridan Street he stopped Eric Anthony Roderick for traveling 61mph in a posted 45 zone. While walking up to the car Deputy Clark smelled marijuana and during a search found the suspect in possession of Xanax without a prescription.

02.26.15 On January 13, 2015 the suspect Blanca Woodard exited the Walmart without paying for \$798.00 worth of merchandise. The suspect fled in a vehicle and loss prevention personnel were able to get a tag number. Detective Gainey followed up and learned the owner of the car had allowed the suspect to use the car. Video images from the store confirmed it was Blanca Woodard. Suspect was arrested and charged with Grand Theft.




