



Subject: March City Manager's Report

During the month of March, Deputies assigned to the Cooper City District responded to 2525 calls for service. Of these calls for service, a total of 36 are Part One (Persons and Property Crimes). The remaining 2,489 calls are alarms, police service suspicious incidents, 911 hang ups, etc.

There were a total of 5 residential burglaries, 8 conveyance burglaries, 2 Robberies and 2 aggravated assaults. There were 47 arrests during the month in which some are documented below in the Items of Interest section of this report.

A total of 191 code violations were addressed during the month of March. These violations are initiated by Patrol Deputies, Parking Enforcement Personnel and Code Enforcement Inspectors. Many of these cases and will require additional follow-up action.

Also included in this report is a breakdown of the 351 State Traffic Citations and 358 Traffic Warnings issued by District Deputies. The Accident Report by Zone lists a total of 66 accidents investigated by District Deputies during the month of March.

Items of Interests:

03.04.15 Detective Rush observed the defendant Giovanni Gallo run a stop sign at exit from the Walmart parking lot onto Griffin Road. During a traffic stop and investigation the suspect was in possession of alprazolam (Xanax) with the intent to sell. The suspect was arrested and charged accordingly.

03.05.15 Deputy Miller observed a BMW traveling at a high rate of speed along Stirling Road that was also making unsafe lane changes. After a traffic stop investigation revealed the driver/suspect Moshe Aharon Ezrati was in possession of a large amount of marijuana that he was planning on selling. Investigation regarding where the suspect purchased this marijuana and where he was planning on selling the narcotics is on-going.

03.08.15 Deputies responded to a residence where the suspect Justin R. Borghese had committed a battery on another person. During the investigation it was revealed that Justin had an outstanding warrant for theft. During a search of Justin he was also in possession of heroin.

03.10.15 The suspect Elizabeth B. Pozo was arrested for Identify Theft, Theft, Fraud, and Violation of Probation. The suspect assumed the identity of the victim and presented fraudulent checks at Wells Fargo in an attempt to have them cashed.

03.11.15 Detective Rush arrested Austin Craz for Possession of Marijuana with intent to Sell. During a traffic stop the suspect was in possession of marijuana, metal grinder, digital scale, and bags contributing to the charge of intent to sell.

03.16.15 Detective Rush conducted a traffic stop in the 4700 block of Flamingo Road making contact with Shawn Riley. The suspect's driver's license was suspended numerous times. The suspect was arrested for driving with a suspended driver's license. During the search of the suspect's vehicle cocaine and marijuana was located inside the vehicle. The suspect was charged accordingly.

03.16.15 Deputy Neeves responded to a call of a reckless driver in the area of Griffin Road and Flamingo Road. Deputy Neeves located the vehicle at 13300 SW 51 Place. Upon walking up to the vehicle they found the suspect Melissa Heaton smoking from a pipe. Investigation revealed that the suspect was smoking heroin. During a search after arrest additional narcotics were found in the vehicle. The suspect was charged accordingly.

03.17.15 Deputy Petoskey arrested Luis Daniel Medina for residential burglary at 5260 SW 90th Way. The victim called 911 stating that she found a male hiding in her shower when she came home. The suspect fled out of the residence and into his car. Deputies located the vehicle in a parking lot at Griffin and University Drive. The victim identified the suspect as the same person in her shower.

03.23.15 Rolando Romero was arrested for False Imprisonment and Aggravated Battery. The suspect purchased a vehicle engine from the victim Leon McLean. The suspect was upset because the engine was no good. So the suspect tracked the victim down and started an argument. When the victim attempted to leave the suspect blocked the victim in with a motor vehicle. Then the suspect rammed the victim's vehicle several times.




