I. CODE ENFORCEMENT

Handle applicable county court prosecutions for code violations and related activities. Provide legal services for preparation and presentation of cases before city special magistrate; and assist in facilitating the operation of successful special magistrate program (Pablo Tamayo, Douglas Gonzales);

II. LITIGATION

- 1) Defend City in fire assessment case. The Circuit Court granted plaintiff's motion to certify a class of plaintiffs. We had filed a Notice of Appeal of that preliminary ruling to the Fourth District Court of Appeal, as authorized by the City Manager; and have filed the City's Briefs. Oral argument was held at the 4th District on November 5, 2013. By Per Curiam decision of November 14, 2013, the 4th District (without a written opinion) affirmed the Circuit Court's certification of a class of plaintiffs to allow the case to proceed as a class action. Since the appellate court decision returned the case to the Trial Court, the previous stay or hold on trial court proceedings is removed , and the defense of the case will proceed at the Trial Court level pursuant to the several defenses asserted in the City's previously filed Answer and Affirmative Defenses. On June 2, 2014, the Trial Court issued an Agreed Order requiring the Plaintiffs to publish and mail a notice of the pending class action litigation , as required by the rules governing class actions , so that persons who are alleged to be part of the class may know of the class action and may decide whether to remain in or exclude themselves from the class action as the case proceeds. Plaintiffs mailed and published a notice, and have recently repeating the notice process because of a defect in the return mailing address that they used in the first attempted notice. The discovery process is on-going. Plaintiffs filed a motion for partial summary judgment. Plaintiffs recently filed an amended motion for partial summary judgment. We have

examined that amended motion, and we will be responding to it. A hearing is scheduled on the motion for partial summary judgment on July 7, 2015. No trial date has been set. (Matt Mandel, Jamie Cole);

- 2) Assist City staff in coordination and monitoring of liability claims and cases handled by FMIT insurance counsel.

III. OTHER MATTERS

- 1) Handle labor issues and provide labor related advice for Human Resources (Alison Smith, Brett Schneider);
- 2) Represent City as a party plaintiff in asset distribution litigation against Broward County and in related dispute resolution and mediation proceedings, concerning Resource Recovery Board / Solid Waste system , as authorized by City Commission. An attorney- client session to discuss a potential settlement offer was previously held. Settlement approval has been processed by the largest municipalities, and has also been approved by the Broward County Commission. The Settlement was approved at the City Commission meeting of April 28, 2015, and has recently been approved by all of the other participating cities. Distribution of settlement proceeds to the cities is expected soon. (Jamie Cole, Anthony Soroka , Dan Abbott);
- 3) Advise on implementation of County ethics ordinances, and provide advisory opinions, assistance and advice on public service ethics when requested (David Wolpin, Robert Meyers);
- 4) As requested by City Manager, assist staff with collection of delinquent utility bills including late fees (Aleida Molina , David Wolpin);
- 5) Assist City Manager and Public Works Director on Sidewalk Ordinance amendment implementation (David Wolpin);
- 6) Assist City Manager and Growth Management Director on Public School signage, Sign Code amendment (Kathy Mehaffey, James White, David Wolpin);
- 7) Assist City Manager in determining whether BSO has any objection to police disability pension ordinance amendment which was requested by the Police Pension Board(David Wolpin) ; and
- 8) Examine Agenda Items for June 16, 2015, City Commission meeting (David Wolpin) .





Subject: June 2015 Report

During the month of June, Deputies assigned to the Cooper City District responded to 2572 calls for service. Of these calls for service, a total of 35 are Part One (Persons and Property Crimes). The remaining 2537 calls are alarms, police service suspicious incidents, 911 hang ups, etc.

There were a total of 11 conveyance burglaries and 2 residential burglaries. There were 20 arrests during the month in which some are documented below in the Items of Interest section of this report.

A total of 136 code violations were addressed during the month of June. These violations are initiated by Patrol Deputies, Parking Enforcement Personnel and Code Enforcement Inspectors. Many of these cases and will require additional follow-up action.

Also included in this report is a breakdown of the 333 State Traffic Citations and 258 Traffic Warnings issued by District Deputies. The Accident Report by Zone lists a total of 55 accidents investigated by District Deputies during the month of June, there were no traffic fatalities.

Items of Interest :

06.16.15 Deputy Neves met with Loss Security Officer Felicia Harmon at Walmart who stated that employee Shantinique Nicole Williams removed over \$1,300 in cash from the register over the course of three days. The suspect was arrested and confessed to stealing the funds from the register.

06.17.15 Detective Rush stopped the suspect Earnest Gerald Huck who was driving with an expired tag. During the contact and investigation it was revealed the suspect had a suspended driver's license. The suspect was arrested and during the search the suspect was in possession of Alprazom.

06.18.15 Suspect Peggy Jimmie was involved in a traffic crash. The victim fled the crash in her vehicle at a high rate of speed, running red lights, all because her license was suspended. Deputy Wood was able to locate and stop the suspect who also had her two children in the backseat. The suspect was charged with Child Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Driving With Suspended Driver's License and Leaving the Scene of An Accident.

06.19.15 Randy Devon Jones was arrested on multiple counts of Aggravated Stalking. The suspect was in a four year relationship with the victim when she ended the relationship in February 2015. From February to June the suspect continually harassed the victim. On June 03, 2015 the suspect threw a brick through the victim's vehicle window and then tried to set the vehicle on fire. The suspect then sent a barrage of text messages to the victim saying she and her new boyfriend were going to die. The suspect was arrested and charged with four counts of Aggravated/Cyber Stalking and Criminal Mischief




