

Subject: July 2015 Report

During the month of July, Deputies assigned to the Cooper City District responded to 2593 calls for service. Of these calls for service, a total of 56 are Part One (Persons and Property Crimes). The remaining 2537 calls are alarms, police service suspicious incidents, 911 hang ups, etc.

There were a total of 18 conveyance burglaries, 11 residential burglaries and 1 Homicide. There were 31 arrests during the month in which some are documented below in the Items of Interest section of this report.

A total of 251 code violations were addressed during the month of July. These violations are initiated by Patrol Deputies, Parking Enforcement Personnel and Code Enforcement Inspectors. Many of these cases and will require additional follow-up action.

Also included in this report is a breakdown of the 356 State Traffic Citations and 297 Traffic Warnings issued by District Deputies. The Accident Report by Zone lists a total of 51 accidents investigated by District Deputies during the month of July, there was 1 traffic fatality.

Items of Interest :

07.05.15 Gilberth David Pacheco 09.27.93 was stopped for a traffic violation at Sheridan Street and University Drive. Investigation revealed the subject's license was suspended. During the arrest the suspect was also in possession of Ecstasy and Marijuana.

07.10.15 Taylor Lee King 07.07.92 was arrested for Grand Theft from the Walmart when he attempted to exit the store with \$388.72 worth of merchandise.

07.14.15 Spencer Miles Mulligan was arrested for Grand Theft and Possession of Heroin. The suspect had just stolen \$1,400 from the victim (suspect's mother's boyfriend is the victim) and was fleeing on foot when he was stopped by deputies. During the search of the suspect the heroin was located.

07.21.15 Sonny Joseph Gottlieb and Jesse Jay Gottlieb (brothers) were arrested for Armed Residential Burglary that occurred on 07.14.15. The suspects entered into a home and removed a rifle, Apple iPad, and jewelry valued at over \$2,000. The brothers then pawned the items at a pawn shop in Davie. The suspects were charged with Armed Burglary, Dealing In Stolen Property, and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon.

07.23.15 Ashely Eve Kingsbury was arrested for Possession of Heroin. Deputies responded to a medical call and during the investigative process found the suspect had a warrant for her arrest and was in possession of heroin.

07.25.15 Justin Lamar Swain was arrested for Grand Theft. The suspect entered into the AT&T store located on Sheridan Street and forcefully removed an Apple iPhone from the display area by ripping it from the security cable. The suspect was apprehended a few blocks from the store.

07.25.15 Jose C. Rivas was stopped for a traffic violation in the 1000 block of Griffin Road. During the investigation it was revealed the suspect did not have a valid driver's license. During a search after arrest the suspect was in possession of cocaine.




