CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES.
JUNE 16, 2016

1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner Mallozzi opened the meeting at 6:41 PM and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed for the events that unfolded in Orlando.

4. PRESENTATION OF BSO AUDIT BY MATRIX CONSULTING GROUP

Richard Brady from Matrix Consulting Group presented the results of the BSO audit, the report evaluates and analyzes the contract and the services provided by the Broward County Sheriff's Office. Starting off with the Police the audit recommended a revise to contract terms that would require personnel to serve a minimum of 2 years in Cooper City unless they receive a promotion that requires a transfer out of the district. The report also recommended deputy-initiated incidents should be recorded with greater detail, and used to develop and present statistics on how proactive time is utilized. The audit also recommended that Fire personnel serve a minimum of a 2 year contract, as well as work with the City to develop performance measures for call processing, turnout, and travel times specific to the call processing and response time. The audit also mentioned the City should develop a station location study to determine if the current station should be relocated after construction of a second station to improve service to the north and southwestern portions of Cooper City.
