1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Ross opened the meeting at 6:31 PM and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. ROLL CALL

Present were Commissioners Green, Curran, Mallozzi and Mayor Ross. Commissioner Sims was absent.

3. AGENDA CONCERNS

Michael Mogerman, 11529 SW 51 Street, thanked the Commission for their support of the Teal Pumpkin Project.

4. PRESENTATION

Gianno Feoli from Calvin, Giordano & Associates presented possible improvement options for the area around the apartments located at SW 90th Way & SW 91st Ave. Mr. Feoli first addressed the current conditions, noting issues with the parking, tree conditions, sidewalks and the asphalt. He presented 3 possible options for the Commission to consider.

- Option one was the most cost efficient at an estimated cost of \$170,799.00. This option includes repairs to the asphalt, sidewalks and gutters while leaving the roadway and trees in their current configuration.
- Option two has an estimated cost of \$561,111.00. It includes travel lanes being reduced to 10 feet and the large oak trees being replaced with smaller Dahoon Holly trees, and the addition of new lighting.
- Option three has an estimated cost of \$706,078.00, which includes travel lanes being reduced to a single 1-way lane with colored warning strips, parking immediately in front of the courtyard area and the large oak trees being replaced with the Dahoon Holly trees. Option three also includes parking widths being reset to code minimum and new street lighting.
