DATE: Saturday, March 11, 2017 from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
DESCRIPTION: Afternoon of activities & events, featuring free entertainment, and a spectacular fireworks display held at Brian Piccolo Broward County Park.
LOCATION: Brian Piccolo Park, 9501 Sheridan Street, Cooper City, Florida 33024
Expected Attendees at Founder's Day: over 3,000 residents.
FEE: \$35.00 plus tax (\$37.10 total)- Outside 12'x12' grass space. Limited to 14 booths. NO tents, tables or electricity provided. No day-of-event refunds or rain date.

VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Items must be original art or creative & handmade crafts.
- Founder's Day is a family event; the Founder's Day Committee reserves the right to disallow any activity or objectionable material from being displayed, sold, or distributed in any manner.
- Novelty or commercial type items, posters, food, fireworks, sparklers, and commercial-type items CANNOT be displayed or sold in the Arts & Crafts area by participating artists and artisans or their representatives. Raffles/Games of chance are not allowed by vendor.
- Exhibitors are responsible for collecting and paying Florida sales tax.
- All exhibitors/event participants will be charged a Broward County park entrance fee of \$1.50 per person upon entry into the park.
- Exhibitor setup is between 1:00 p.m.– 3:00 p.m. Exhibitors may not set up prior to 1:00 p.m.
- Exhibitors are to be setup by 3:00 p.m. and can begin to dismantle after 7:00 p.m. Exhibitors have the option of remaining until events conclude at 9:00 p.m.
- Those choosing to breakdown early will NOT be able to move their vehicles toward the vendor area until AFTER the Firework presentation (approximately 9:00 p.m.) and will be responsible for their own dismantle.
- Vehicles are not allowed to drive or park on the field. Trailers may not be stored in the parking area. Trailers must be parked in a designated trailer area.
- All exhibitors must supply their own canopy, tables and chairs. The exhibitor is renting a 12' x 12' grass space. Tents must be weighted down on all four sides.
- The City of Cooper City and Brian Piccolo Park accepts no responsibility for damages, theft, injury, or loss of earnings from any activity you participate in during the festival.
- No subletting of contracted space.
