

- Address/name changes (\$25.00)
- ID cards (\$25.00)
- Reinstatements (fees vary)
- Emergency Contact Information Registration (free)
- Renewal/Replace of Vehicle Registrations (No Vessels, Water Craft or HOV Decals)
- Renewal/Replace Disabled Parking Permits (Form HSMV 83039 is required)



Obtaining the Florida Driver License or Identification Card

Florida has new documentation requirements for residents renewing or obtaining a driver license or identification card. Customer Service Center please call (850) 617-2000 or visit our [GatherGoGet](http://gathergoget.com) website (gathergoget.com) for a complete listing of documents needed and other information related to obtaining your driver license or ID card.

For your convenience the Department accepts the following methods of payment: Cash, Check, and Credit Cards.



1 Primary Identification

▲ Gather one original or certified copy of the following documents:

- ✓ Certified United States birth certificate, including territories and District of Columbia
- ✓ Valid United States Passport or Passport Card
- ✓ Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- ✓ Certificate of Naturalization
- ✓ Certificate of Citizenship
- ✓ Valid Alien Registration card (Green card, Form I-551)
- ✓ Valid employment authorization card (Form I688B or I-766)

NOTES***

A birth certificate must be issued by a government agency. **Hospital birth certificates cannot be accepted.**

Please come prepared to present one of the listed identification documents as proof of citizenship or legal presence.

When necessary, marriage certificates, court orders, or divorce decrees must be provided to tie the name on the primary identification to the name the customer would like to place on the driver license or identification card.

If presenting a valid U.S. Passport and the name on your passport is your current name, you are not required to present additional name change documents.

***If in doubt regarding required documents, please visit www.Gathergoget.com . For non-immigrants, please bring all of your US BCIS documentation with you. Certain classifications require additional documentation.

Proof of Social Security Number

- ✓ Social Security card must be an original in your current full name
- ✓ W-2 form (not handwritten)
- ✓ SSA-1099
- ✓ Any 1099 (not handwritten)

▲ Gather **TWO different** documents from the following list showing your residential address: (internet printouts or faxes of these documents are acceptable)

Note: Your current driver license or ID card *may not* be used as proof of residential address. Proof must come from *two different types* of source.

- ✓ Deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or residential rental/lease agreement.
- ✓ Florida Voter Registration Card.
- ✓ Florida Vehicle Registration or Title.
- ✓ Utility bills, not more than two months old.
- ✓ Current automobile insurance policy or bill
- ✓ A signed statement from a parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the applicant resides, combined with two proofs of their residential address.
- ✓ Medical or health card with address listed
- ✓ Educational institution transcript forms for the Current school year
- ✓ Unexpired professional license issued by a government agency in the U.S.
- ✓ Mail from financial institutions
- ✓ Mail from Federal, State, County or City government agencies
