DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

- 2600 "April Kids News" were prepared and distributed to the elementary schools the first week of April.
- Cooper City Adult Luncheon was held on April 17th at the Community Center. The theme was "Cooper City History". Pictures from the historical room were placed on display. Mayor Setti (Mayor during the 1970's) spoke about the first Founder's Day. Participants were requested to bring a picture of themselves from their earlier years and everyone had to guess who was who.
- The Recreation Director met with the Cooper City Optimist Basketball Program liaison in preparations for the summer basketball program at PMS and CCHS.
- Seven Tree Inventory trainings were held throughout the month. 70% of the trees in Cooper City have been inventoried. The Grant funding the project will be finalized in June.
- The Historical Committee met 3 times in April preparing for the Founder's Day Police and Fire Historical display. The display was placed at Brian Piccolo Park under the largest tent for the general public to view.
- Founder's Day was held on Saturday, April 25th. Thanks to everyone on the board who assisted with set up, drivers of dignitary cars, to taking pictures of the parade. The City continues to wait for the number in attendance during the afternoon festivities at Piccolo. Last year the number in attendance exceeded over 4000.
- On-going registrations are currently taking place for Spring Swim Lessons and Summer Youth Camp. The Youth Summer Camp has changes in facility locations this summer. Children entering 1st through 4th Grades will attend camp at the Community Center. 5th – 7th grades will attend camp at CCHS. The tennis camp, summer swim lessons, Silversneakers classes, youth classes and adult program activities, fitness room, open swim, basketball and tennis, and more will be held at the Pool & Tennis Center.
- Recreation Staff continue preparations for the following upcoming events and activities: Mother/Daughter Tea, Saturday, May 9th at the Community Center, Summer Camp, Summer Swim Lessons, and Touch-A-Truck on June 20th.
