**RECREATIONN DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

- ✓ Since no quorum last month, updates for April/May are:
  - Cooper City Founder's Day*** was held on Saturday, April 30th and was another huge success. Weather was beautiful. Started with One Mile Family Fun Run/Walk with about 200 participants. Griffin Elementary school was the winning school with the most Elementary School participation to receive the \$100 donation to PTA. Following the One Mile Run/Walk was the parade. There were 35 units that participated with several individual trucks, floats and boats from Cooper City Optimist teams as usual. The boy scouts Pancake Breakfast was a sell out and had about 125 participants. Then the festivities continued in the afternoon at Brian Piccolo Park with the Business Expo (12 booths), Arts and Craft vendors (10 booths), and Non-Profit food vendors (5 booths - CCHS band, CCHS JROTC, Cooper City Cyclones Swim Team, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts). The live band concert was Big City Dogs and was a big hit with the crowd. The event concluded with Fireworks.
- ✓ ***Mother/Daughter Tea*** took place on Saturday, May 7th. Ticket sales began April 6th and were sold out in one and a half days. There were 100 participants that enjoyed tea time and sampled a wide variety of flavored teas along with lunch. The South Florida Cloggers provided dance entertainment and all the daughters decorated a foam picture frame with a picture that was taken of their family when they arrived. In honor of Mother's Day, all mothers also received a pink carnation along with their decorated picture frame. The event concluded with a raffle drawing for 10 prize packets for the daughters and 5 prizes of gift certificates for the moms.
- ✓ ***Mom's Day at the Pool*** took place on Sunday, May 8th where Cooper City moms were able to enjoy the day of the Cooper City Pool for free. There were about 100 participants that enjoyed the day at the pool with their mom.

-June 25th - **Touch-A-Truck** will be held at the Cooper City Sports Complex from 9 am - 12 noon. There will be a variety of police, fire, public works and utility vehicles. In addition, the recreation bus, garbage truck, construction vehicles and others will also be on display. There will be a DJ playing music and a variety of games for the children. Concession items will be available for purchase provided by the Cooper City Optimist. The event will be fun for kids of all ages.

-July 15th - **Food Truck Rolling Into Cooper City** will be held at the Cooper City Sports Complex from 5:30 pm - 9:30 pm. Vendor applications have been e-mailed to previous vendors and any new vendor that has already contacted the City.
