

**CITY OF COOPER CITY
CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP MINUTES
MAY 16, 2017
6:30 PM**

1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Ross opened the meeting at 6:30 PM and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. ROLL CALL

Present were Commissioners Green, Curran, Sims, and Mayor Ross. Commissioner Mallozzi was absent.

3. AGENDA CONCERNS

None.

4. BUDGET INPUT

Commissioner Green requested an update on when the renovations to the City Hall parking lot would be completed and Public Works Director Denise Yoezle explained that it was 3 to 4 months away from breaking ground on the project. He requested that staff provide a cost analysis for Wi-Fi at the Pool & Tennis Center and the Community Center as well as setting up a computer training lab with internet access at the Community Center for residents.

Commissioner Curran expressed disappointment and confusion with the backup and requested that items listed be color coded to denote which items were completed versus open and better clarification be provided for the items listed. He asked for and received clarification on how much grant money has been received or designated for each item listed where applicable; questioned the need for a generator for the Community Center. He advised that the Flamingo West Park project needs to be completed and the issue of artificial turf be addressed.

Commissioner Sims requested clarification regarding the bathroom at the Sports Complex, which has been completed, and the IT Room renovation, which is now proposed to be included in the new Public Works building.

Mayor Ross requested that staff find a solution to the problem of limited cellular reception in the City Hall building; a cost analysis for providing Wi-Fi in the parks, and classes for iPhone use be included in the computer training lab. He requested that additional bus benches be purchased and installed in various locations throughout the City. He

advised that he does not want to just keep receiving credits for the three BSO Law Enforcement vacancies and that those vacancies need to be filled.

The Commission was advised that the IT Manager position will be filled in two weeks.

Ms. Yoezle clarified that the \$800,000 designated for "Repair Sidewalks" also includes guardrails and street resurfacing.

5. ADJOURNMENT
