Water Main Replacement Program Completed in 2017



Cooper City's water main replacement program is close to completion. The 4 year program to replace all of the old concrete composite water mains throughout the City should be completed in March or April 2017.

This map illustrates the final stage of the project. This program has benefited the city by improving the reliability of its water system, and reducing emergency repairs with the associated boil water advisories. Please call the City's Utilities Department at 954-434-5519 BEFORE you call a plumber! We are available to assist you 24 hours a day, and the visit is free. If your plumbing problem is on the City's side, we will resolve it. If you call a plumber before you call us, the plumber will charge you regardless of where the problem is and we won't be able to help you with that plumbing bill, even if the problem is on the City side, so PLEASE call us first.
