1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Ross opened the meeting at 6:30 PM leading the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. BUDGET INPUT

City Manager Loucks advised that the meeting is the first of two Budget Workshops and that a Special Commission Meeting is scheduled on July 31, 2018 to adopt the proposed millage rates and assessments. City Manager Loucks advised the mileage rate is expected not to increase. The City will provide for fire services funded partially by a special assessment, which reflects no increase for the past five years. The Water and Sewer rates will increase in accordance to City policy from the recent CPI. The Storage Lot Fund budget reflects no increase and other than a recently approved grant for lighting at Bill Lipps Sports Park, no expenditures were budgeted for either Bill

Lipps or the Sports Complex, pending outcome of the bond referendum. Reserves of 3.1 million were used to address Hurricane Irma costs and to date, no FEMA reimbursements have been received.
