

**CITY OF COOPER CITY
CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP
JUNE 4, 2013**

1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Ross opened the workshop at 6:30 p.m. and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. ROLL CALL

Present were Commissioners Green, Curran, Sims, Mallozzi, and Mayor Ross.

3. AGENDA CONCERNS

Rena Ferrara, 4911 SW 88 Terrace, described speeding and traffic concerns on her street and asked for a solution.

Sunny Riling, 8800 SW 49th Street, explained that there is a speeding issue on her street and asked the Commission to find a remedy.

Diana Makohin, 5054 SW 88th Terrace, suggested placing stop signs at the turns and before the bridge, and increasing police presence in lieu of adding speed humps.

Jane Fleming, 5180 SW 88th Terrace, suggested increased police presence and/or warning signs in lieu of speed humps.

David Fleming, 5180 SW 88th Terrace, spoke in favor of communication and against speed humps.

4. DISCUSSION OF TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES

A. PowerPoint Presentation

Jeff Maxwell, Director of Traffic Engineering with Calvin, Giordiano and Associates provided the presentation illustrating traffic concerns and solutions. He explained the methods used in conducting traffic calming studies and in calculating traffic, speed, and accident probability.

B. Proposed Amendment to Traffic Calming Ordinance

Discussion by the Commission resulted in a general consensus to reject, at this time, a waiver clause as presented in the proposed amendment.

Kim Friday, 5049 SW 88th Terrace, suggested that reflectors be placed leading into and throughout the turning curve and explained

that drivers tend to slow down automatically when asked to and when children are at play near the roadway.

The City Commission agreed to create a signage and awareness campaign and to investigate whether the County would approve a stop sign in the area.

5. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 7:53 p.m.
