4. CODE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Commissioner Sims requested a consensus of the Commission to direct the two advisory boards to develop preliminary guidelines to be presented to the Commission. Consensus was signified with no opposition.

Commissioner Curran requested that the Special Magistrate provide additional time for residence who are currently in violation and may qualify for assistance through this program.
