

Residential Bulk Collection Program:

Residential bulk waste collection will be provided monthly on scheduled collection days. See map for your collection day.

Please adhere to the following collection rules:

- ★ **Bulk Waste** is limited to 6 cubic yards per pickup and placed not more than three (3) feet from the curb or roadway in front of your residence.
- ★ **Yard Trash** may be placed in the roll-out cart. Excess yard trash not placed in a roll-out cart must meet the following requirements with regard to any single piece of material: the weight shall not exceed forty (40) pounds; the material must be less than six (6) feet in length and less than six (6) inches in diameter; the material shall be neatly stacked, tied or secured in such a manner that prevents spillage when collected.
- ★ **Certain Loose Bulk Trash Items:** (i.e. rock, gravel, mulch etc.) must be set out in a container with the weight of the contents, including loose rock, not to exceed forty (40) pounds.
- ★ **Glass Items:** All glass items/materials must be placed in a sturdy rigid container(s) for safe collection. Do not place glass items in with your regular bulk items. Instead, place the glass items adjacent to the bulk items to facilitate separate handling.
- ★ **Vegetative Waste:** This includes, but is not limited to, shrub and tree trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, and tree branches. Vegetative Waste must be a part of normal yard maintenance and be generated by the customer at the Residential Service Unit. Vegetative waste individual item must not exceed six (6) feet in length, twelve (12) inches in diameter and weigh less than 40 pounds.

BULK TRASH ACCEPTED ✓:

- ✓ **Household Goods** - Appliances, furniture, mattresses, toys, carpets (bundled and tied in correct lengths and weight), and other items normally found in the household. White Goods, i.e. washer dryer, stove, refrigerator, air conditioners are collected. (Freon must be removed and tagged accordingly).
- ✓ **Incidental Debris** from self-home improvement projects is permitted.
- ✓ **Only Resident** generated repair debris materials will be collected.
- ✓ **Vegetative Waste** - Trimmings from bushes, shrubs, frons, branches may be placed in the cart or as described above under Yard Trash.

BULK TRASH NOT ACCEPTED ✗:

- ✗ **Construction Debris:** Construction or building materials from commercial contractor generated work is not accepted.
- ✗ **Automobile or Marine:** Parts, engines, etc.
- ✗ **Miscellaneous:** No dirt, rocks or sod.
- ✗ **Absolutely no hazardous wastes.**
- ✗ **Do not mix garbage with bulk.**

RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION

- A) Residents may place at the curb up to two roll-out carts for regular waste collection service.
- B) Additional roll-out carts may be utilized by those residents requiring more service than the “base” plan. These “extra carts” must be subscribed to and prepaid in advance, at a rate of \$8.75 (eight dollars and seventy-five cents) per month per cart (other charges apply).
- C) Residents that have more than two carts will be required to either:
 - a. Subscribe for additional service by calling our Sales Department at (954) 974-7500.
 - b. Return the extra carts by contacting our Customer Service Department at (954) 974-7500.
- D) Unregistered Carts will not be serviced on garbage collection days.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING COLLECTION ITEMS:

Recycle only the following CLEAN, DRY, and LOOSE items: Metal containers, plastic containers, paper, and cardboard. **DO NOT PLACE** non-recyclable items like PLASTIC BAGS, STYROFOAM, FOOD WASTE, etc. in the recycling cart.

BULK TRASH COLLECTION

Bulk should be placed curbside on the day before collection, however, if necessary, bulk may be placed curbside as early as the Saturday before collection. Items placed curbside outside of the designated collection schedule will be subject to violation.

Bulk trash includes large household trash that does not fit in roll-out carts or bags. **No black bags will be collected with bulk.**

Acceptable bulk items include:

- Furniture, mattresses, white goods (washer, dryer, etc.), appliances, refrigerators (with freon removed), carpets & paddings, yard waste in clear bags, tree branches, & other yard waste.

Secure loose items such as carpeting, cardboard, etc.. Place glass in a rigid container that can be lifted safely. Keep solid waste blue bags separate from bulk waste. Do not place bulk near mailboxes, power poles, etc., to allow for easy collection.

Vegetative Waste This includes, but is not limited to, shrub and tree trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, and tree branches. Vegetative Waste must be a part of normal yard maintenance and be generated by the customer at the Residential Service Unit. Vegetative waste individual item must not exceed six (6) feet in length, twelve (12) inches in diameter and weigh less than 40 pounds.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes paint, batteries, tires and similar materials. Electronic Materials include computers, computer monitors, televisions, printers, scanners, and similar devices. Neither HHW nor Electronic Materials are collected as solid waste, recyclable, or bulk trash. The City offers four quarterly drop-off events, which allow residents to dispose of these materials. This is available for Cooper City residents only, proof of residency will be required.
