ORDINANCE NO. 19-9-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE OPERATING MILLAGE RATE OF 6.8102 OR \$6.8102 PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF TAXABLE ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUE, WHICH IS EQUAL TO THE ROLLED-BACK RATE OF 6.8102, FOR THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO THE 2019-2020 CITY BUDGET, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 200, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE TO THE BROWARD COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a tentative budget has been prepared estimating expenses and revenues of the City of Cooper City, Florida, for the ensuing year, with detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad valorem levy, and the City's professional staff has made recommendations as to the amount necessary to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, a method is prescribed for fixing the millage for the purpose of establishing the basis for the collection of said funds; and

WHEREAS, the total effective taxable valuation on property, both real and personal, in the City of Cooper City, Florida, subject to assessment for taxation to raise revenue for the fiscal year, beginning October 1, 2019 and ending on September 30, 2020, as reported by the Broward County Tax Assessor, is approximately \$3,034,105,952; and

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WHEREAS, the City of Cooper City, Florida, pursuant to State Statute, now desires to adopt the City's operating millage at 6.8102;and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that establishing an operating millage rate of 6.8102 for FY2019-2020 is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Cooper City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.

Section 2. The requisite advertisements, public hearings and ordinances necessary to establish the City millage shall be conducted and prepared.

Section 3. Pursuant to Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, a Public Hearing shall be held on the 12th day of September, 2019, and a second Public Hearing shall be held on the 25th day of September, 2019.

Section 4. After conducting the requisite public hearings, the City's operating millage shall be set at 6.8102, which equal to the rolled-back rate of 6.8102.

Section 5. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be furnished to the Broward County Property Appraiser so that said revenues may be collected and furnished to the City of Cooper City.

Section 6. If any clause, section, or other part or application of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as

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eliminated and so not affecting the validity of the remaining portions or applications remaining in full force or effect.

Section 7. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
